For students of Budapest Business School

FREE CHINESE, KOREAN AND INDONESIAN LANGUAGE COURSES IN THE 2021/2022 SPRING SEMESTER

The Oriental Business and Innovation Center (OBIC) is publishing its call for application for extracurricular Chinese, Korean and Indonesian language courses free of charge.

OBIC was established by Budapest Business School and Magyar Nemzeti Bank (the Central Bank of Hungary) in 2016. Its main objective is to contribute to the education of experts who can speak East Asian languages and are familiar with the cultures and economies of East Asian countries. Within this framework, OBIC offers the possibility for the students of Budapest Business School to take part in Oriental language courses free of charge.

Details:

- Full-time students enrolled at Budapest Business School with an active semester are entitled to participate in one of the offered courses.
- The classes will start on the week of 21st February 2022.
- The courses last for 10 weeks.
- Classes are held twice a week, in 2*45-minute-long sessions with a group of maximum 20 people (and a course starts with a minimum of 5 students).
- The venues of the classes will be the buildings of Budapest Business School in Berzsenyi Street and Diósy Lajos Street or online depending on the course.
- The Korean courses will be held with the support of the Korean Cultural Center, while the Indonesian classes are the courtesy of the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Hungary.

Teachers: native language lecturers, thus the language of education will be English (the use of Hungarian can be expected in the Chinese classes).

General requirements:

- Regular attendance (4 absences permitted).
- Written and oral exam at the end of the semester.
- Attending at least one OBIC event during the semester.
- Language prerequisites (materials covered until now):
 - o Chinese: BCT Standard Course 1 first 12 lessons
 - o Korean:
 - Ko3: knowledge of Korean alphabet and basic communication
 - Ko4: Ewha 1-2 first 15 lessons
 - o Indonesian: Sahabatku Indonesia BIPA 1 basic communication (e.g. introduction, hobbies, family, travelling, directions)
