





VISA REQUIREMENTS

UIO will facilitate students with any inquiries during the visa application process.

Please be informed that effective 15 December 2016, all students must obtain single-entry visa from the Malaysian Embassy of the Home Country prior to entering Malaysia.

DO NOT PURCHASE FLIGHT TICKET BEFORE RECEIVING THE SINGLE-ENTRY VISA FROM THE MALAYSIAN EMBASSY/ HIGH COMMISSION AT YOUR HOME COUNTRY.

In the absence of Malaysian Embassy/ High Commission at your home country (for example Portugal, you may obtain your Visa on Arrival at the airport in Malaysia upon your arrival).

Student may apply for the visa online through EMGS website once they receive Acceptance Letter and Visa Application Guidelines from UIO.


Note: You may be required to re-submit/add documentation depending on EMGS requirement during the visa application process.

Payment: You need to make the visa payment directly to EMGS through credit card during your visa application.


Upon approval and receipt of the VAL (Visa Approval Letter), UIO will notify the student and the Home University. Student can download the VAL through their EMGS account/ Mobile apps.

Student must immediately apply for a single-entry pass from the Malaysian Embassy/ Malaysian Representative Office in the home university country.

Upon arrival in Malaysia and after having passed the Medical Screening, UIO will collect passport from the students and submit to EMGS/Immigration to get the visa sticker on it.

The amount varies as it depends on the citizenship, duration of the mobility and other varying factors

MEDICAL SCREENING UPON ARRIVAL IN MALAYSIA RM 250

I-KAD (expatriate identification card) RM 50

POSTARRIVAL

All students are required to attend a medical examination once they have arrived in Malaysia in any of the EMGS Panel clinics listed (https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/how-to-apply/medical-screening/registered-overseas-clinics.html/) within SEVEN (7) days of arrival. Any students who fail this medical screening will not be issued with a student pass and will be required to leave the country. This medical test includes drug/cannabis test too: please be more attentive to this matter, as drug laws in Malaysia may differ from those in the other countries.

UniKL DRESS CODE

Students must be appropriately dressed when in lecture halls, administration offices, labs, during practical trainings, library, religious places and any other places within UniKL Campus at all time.

The dress code at UniKL is long pants with collared shirt/polo shirt for male students and long pants/blouse or knee length skirt/ dress for female students.















UIO WELCOMING SERVICE

Airport pickup is offered on the dates that will be specified by UniKL International Office. This information will be sent via email and students should provide full information (such as flight number, date and time) in the form that will be attached in the email.

Campus transfer is offered to exchange students going to campuses outside of Kuala Lumpur and Selangor, subject to the availability of UniKL transportation.

LIVING EXPENSES IN KUALA LUMPUR

The average living cost per month is around RM2000 – RM3000 in Kuala Lumpur. This estimation varies depending on location and type of accommodation, food and phone bills, wi-fi and other expenses.

It is generally cheaper in other cities/States outside of Kuala Lumpur.
