



# CALL FOR APPLICATION

For students of Budapest Business University

## FREE CHINESE AND INDONESIAN LANGUAGE COURSES IN THE 2023/2024 FALL SEMESTER

The Oriental Business and Innovation Center (OBIC) is publishing its call for application for extracurricular Chinese and Indonesian language courses free of charge.

OBIC was established by Budapest Business School and Magyar Nemzeti Bank (the Central Bank of Hungary) in 2016. Its main objective is to contribute to the education of experts who can speak East Asian languages and are familiar with the cultures and economies of East Asian countries. Within this framework, OBIC offers the possibility for the students of Budapest Business University to take part in Oriental language courses free of charge.

### Details:

- Full-time students enrolled at Budapest Business School with an active semester are entitled to participate in one of the offered courses.
- **The classes will start on the week commencing on 25 September 2022.**
- The Chinese course lasts for 10 weeks, lessons are held twice a week, in 2\*45-minute-long sessions with a maximum of 20 students (minimum number required is 5).
- The Indonesian course lasts for 11 weeks, lessons are held twice a week, in 1\*60-minute long session with a maximum of 18 students (minimum number required is 5).
- The venues of the classes will be the buildings of Budapest Business University in **Berzsenyi Street** and **Diósy Lajos Street** depending on the course.
- The Chinese course will be held with the support of the *Confucius Institute of Szeged*, while the Indonesian course will be held with the aid of **the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia**.

**Teachers:** native language lecturers, thus **the language of education will be English** (the use of Hungarian is possible in the Chinese class).

**General requirements:**

- Regular attendance (4 absences permitted during the semester).
- Written and oral exam at the end of the semester.
- Attending at least one OBIC event during the semester.
- Language prerequisites: none.

**Application:**

- Registrations are considered with a view to keeping balance among the students from all faculties.
