FREE INDONESIAN LANGUAGE COURSE IN THE SPRING SEMESTER OF 2023/24

The Oriental Business and Innovation Center (OBIC) is publishing its call for application for extracurricular Indonesian language course, free of charge.

OBIC was established by Budapest Business University and Magyar Nemzeti Bank (the Central Bank of Hungary) in 2016. Its main objective is to contribute to the education of experts who can speak East Asian languages and are familiar with the cultures and economies of East Asian countries. Within this framework, OBIC offers the possibility for the students of Budapest Business School to take part in Oriental language courses free of charge.

This spring will bring a truly unique opportunity to us because the course will be held in cooperation and with the aid of the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Budapest, where students will be taught by diplomats serving at the embassy. As a result, this course is not a simple language course, but an extraordinary chance to get to know the Indonesian culture, customs and people in great detail. Once a month, the class will be held in the embassy building. After completing the course, all successful students will receive a certificate signed by the Ambassador. Besides, the course could be recognized as an elective course, baring three credits.

Deatils:

- All students with an active status and the teachers of BBU can attend the course for free of charge.
- The course will start in the week commencing on 19 February 2024, and last for 10 weeks.
- Classes will be held twice a week with a 2*45 minutes lesson each time, with a maximum of 20 students (the minimum number for starting a group is 5).
- The classes will be held at the Berzsenyi street building (with occasional classes at the embassy's building)
- Timetable: Mondays and Wednesdays, 15:25-17:00

Instructors: diplomats of the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Budapest, therefore the language of the course will be: English

Requirements:

- Regular class attendance (4 absences allowed per semester).
- Completion of the final paper and oral examination at the end of the semester.
- Participation in at least on event organised by OBIC during the semester.
- Language prerequisites: none.

When forming the groups, we will aim at keeping the balance between the faculties.
